

ORDINANCE NO. 3339 C.S.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONTEREY AMENDING CERTAIN TIME LIMITATIONS WITH RESPECT TO THE REDEVELOPMENT PLAN FOR THE GREATER DOWNTOWN PROJECT AREA.

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONTEREY DOES ORDAIN, as follows:

SECTION 1: The City Council of the City of Monterey approved and adopted the Redevelopment Plan for the Greater Downtown Redevelopment Project Area of the Redevelopment Agency of the City of Monterey by the City's Ordinance No. 2518, adopted on July 19, 1983.

SECTION 2: On November 15, 1994, the City Council, pursuant to Ordinance No. 3164 of the City, approved and adopted an amendment to the Redevelopment Plan making certain changes to the text of the Redevelopment Plan.

SECTION 3: Pursuant to Health and Safety Code Section 33681.9, which was added by SB 1045 which took effect on September 1, 2003, the Agency is required during the 2003-04 fiscal year to make a payment for deposit in Monterey County's Educational Revenue Augmentation Fund; and

SECTION 4: Pursuant to Health and Safety Code Section 33333.6, which was amended by SB 1045 to provide that when an agency is required to make a payment pursuant to Section 33681.9, the legislative body may amend the redevelopment plan to extend by one year the time limit of the effectiveness of the plan and the time limit to repay indebtedness.

SECTION 5: The time limit on the effectiveness of the Redevelopment Plan of the Greater Downtown Project Area, as set forth in Article VIII as established by Ordinance No. 3162 of the City, shall be amended as follows: "...the effectiveness of this Plan shall terminate on August 19, 2019...".

SECTION 6: The Agency shall not pay indebtedness or receive property taxes pursuant to Health and Safety Code Section 33670 after ten (10) years from the termination of the effectiveness of the Redevelopment Plan. Based upon the termination date established in Section 14 of this Ordinance, the Agency shall not pay indebtedness or receive property taxes pursuant to Section 33670 after August 19, 2029.

SECTION 7: Ordinance No. 3164 is continued in full force and effect except as amended by this Ordinance.

SECTION 8: If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance. The City Council hereby declares that it would have passed this Ordinance and each section, subsection, sentence, clause and phrase hereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 9: The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this Ordinance and is hereby directed to publish this Ordinance in accordance with law.




